TENTS



Arrow Two



For the past 3 years Wiggy's has been importing tents from Australia. They are unique in their engineering. The fly is set up first and the tent is then suspended from the fly with hooks and loops. One of the interesting aspects of this method of setting up a tent is that you need not set the tent into the fly if the weather is warm. You wind up with considerably extra space. Also, if the weather is warm and a tent is not needed, you can reduce your carrying weight by about 1/2. The tents are single-ply taffeta and the fly is waterproof ripstop nylon. The floor of the tent is waterproof single-ply taffeta. All seams are taped and heat-sealed. The poles are shock corded Easton aluminum.

This is the second model the company made, which explains its name. The tent is a down-sized version of the Arrow One. It only has 2 poles and its size is 5' x 8' with a center height of 3 feet.

Product #: 5.4.1

This model is the first the company in Australia made. It is a 3-pole tunnel tent ideal for 3 people, possibly 4. This is truly an all-season tent. Floor space is approximately 8 feet across at the entrance and tapers to approximately 3 feet as you go to the rear. The length is 12 feet. The height at the center front is 4 feet. Weights 8 lbs.

Hooch

Product #: 5.3.1

A slang term used by soldiers for a make shift shelter. Generally they would use their poncho. We now offer an updated version of a Hootch. The fabric is waterproof single ply nylon taffeta. All seams are taped. There are five loops across the middle to suspend the Hootch when creating an A frame shelter or teepee shape. Two snaps on the center webbing can mate to snaps on the edge to create a poncho. Two or more Hootches can be joined by snaps to increase size. Each of the long sides has six stake down points. There is a stuff sack attached to the Hootch. When the Hootch is inserted in the stuff sack, two keepers (clips) are visible to allow it to attach to a belt, such as web belt.
